PRIVACY NOTICE FOR GALWAY MASTERS BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION MEMBERS

We respect your privacy. This document is to explain how we may use personal information we collect before, during and after your membership with us. This notice explains how we comply with the law on data protection, what your rights are and for the purposes of data protection we will be the controller of any of your personal information.

This notice applies to you if you are a player, supporter, coach, official, team manager or anyone who wishes to be Associated with Galway Masters.

For the purpose of this document, we, our and us refers to the Galway Masters Basketball Association, C/o The Sports Office, NUIG Kingfisher, Galway, Ireland.

We have not appointed a Data Protection Officer to oversee our compliance with data protection laws as we are not required to do so, but our chairperson has overall responsibility for data protection compliance in our organisation.

1. PERSONAL INFORMATION WE MAY COLLECT FROM YOU

When you sign up for membership with us, you may provide us with or we may obtain **personal information** about you, such as information regarding your:

personal contact details that allows us to contact you directly such as name, title, email addresses, address and telephone numbers, date of birth &gender.

Please note however that the withdrawal of your consent will not affect any use of the data made before you withdrew your consent and we may still be entitled to hold and process the relevant personal information to the extent that we are entitled to do so on the bases other than your consent. Withdrawing consent may also have the same effects as not providing the information in the first place, for example we may no longer be able to provide certain member benefits to you.

3. DIRECT MARKETING - we do not engage in direct marketing.

4. DISCLOSURE OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We do not disclose personal information to anyone without prior written consent.

5. HOW LONG DO WE KEEP PERSONAL INFORMATION FOR?

We retain your details on our database for 2 years. After our tournament in completed any member participating in our event 2 year previously who has not renewed their membership in the current year will be deleted.

6. YOUR RIGHTS IN RELATION TO PERSONAL INFORMATION

You have the following rights in relation to your personal information:

To be informed about how your personal information is being used;

To access the personal information we hold about you;

To request the correction of inaccurate personal information we hold about you;

To request the erasure of your personal information in certain limited circumstances;

To restrict processing of your personal information where certain requirements are met;

To object to the processing of your personal information;

To request that we transfer elements of your data either to you or another service provider; and To object to certain automated decision-making processes using your personal information.
